

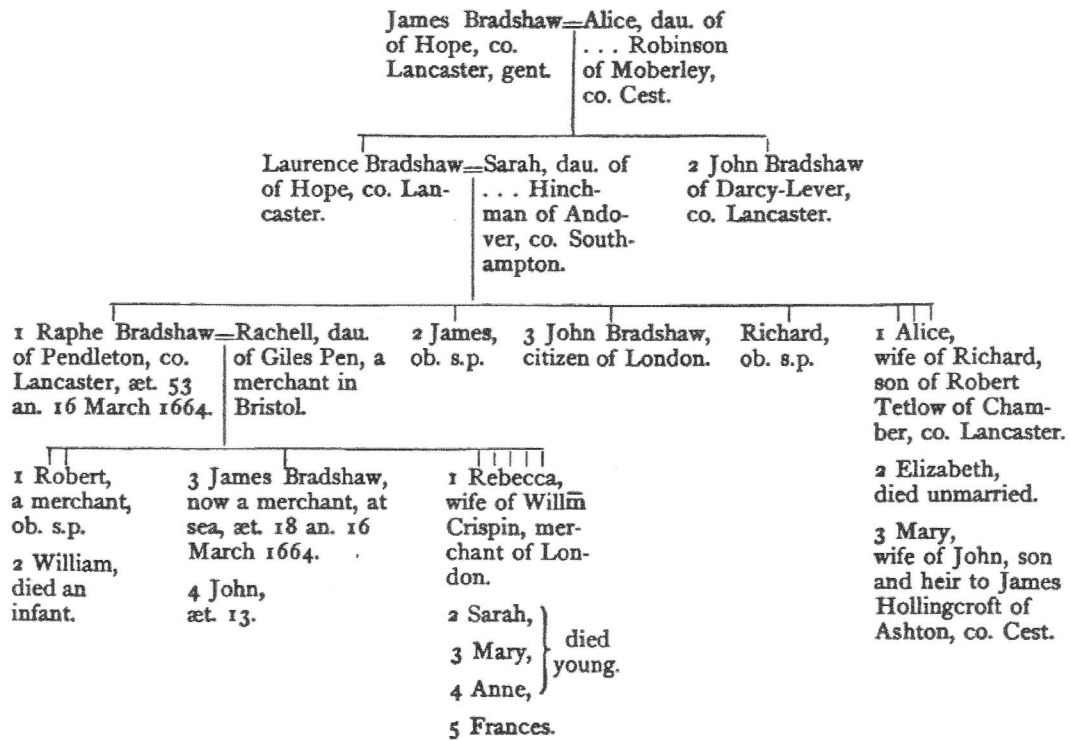

**Arms.** — Argent, two bendlets between as many martlets, sable, a cinquefoil in the fess point, gules.  
**Crest.** — In front of an oak tree, a stag statant, proper.
