ANNIE LANE  
DIED BY DEATH

Mother of Beaumonters Dies  
At Her Home in New  
Iberia, La.

NEW IBERIA, La., Feb. 12. — (Spl)—Mrs. Annie Laurie Lane, 84, mother of two Beaumonters, died at her home here Sunday night. She had been ill for four weeks, following a fall in which she injured a hip.

Funeral services will be held at 4 o'clock Monday afternoon in the New Iberia Methodist church, of which she had been a lifelong member.

Mrs. Lane, a native of New Iberia, was the widow of James R. Lane.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. James A. Giblin of Beaumont and Mrs. John Bouse of Point Bolivar; three sons, W. C. Lane of Beaumont, M. M. Lane of Dallas and James R. Lane of Bosier, La.; a sister, Mrs. Mary Lewis of Montpelier, La.; 18 grandchildren and 28 great-grandchildren.

TO THE POSTMASTER:

Dear Madam:

Receipt is acknowledged of your letter advising of the death of your mother, Mrs. Annie L. Lane.


You are informed that the burial allowance authorized by law is payable only in cases of deceased veterans who received an honorable discharge from war service. This benefit does not extend to relatives of the veterans; therefore no amount may be paid by this office on your mother's burial expenses.

The pension accruing from the date of last payment to the date of her death may, however, be paid as reimbursement to the person responsible for payment of the expenses incurred during her last illness and burial, provided there is no surviving child under the age of sixteen years, and further provided that the assets of the pensioner's estate were not sufficient to meet all expenses.

If the facts warrant, claim may be filed on the enclosed Form 5036 which should be executed in accordance with instructions therein and returned to this office accompanied by itemized bills covering all expenses incurred during her last illness and burial. There should also be forwarded copy of the public record of her death, certified to be a true copy of the original record, over the signature and official seal of the issuing officer.

All communications relative to this case should bear the name of the veteran and refer to the number XC-2,672,697.

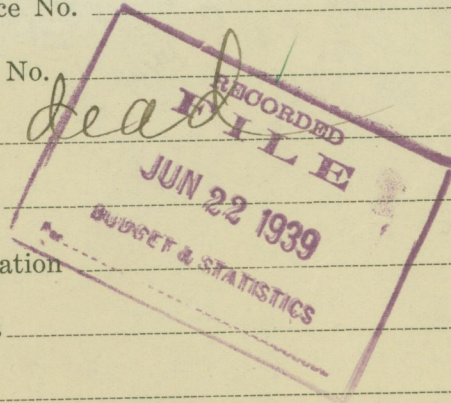
